What is the "story" Christian Nationalism tells?

Christian Nationalism defines 'the people' in a way that excludes many Americans." Specifically, "it defines national belonging in terms of race, religion, and native birth."

The story Christian Nationalism tells about who is "worthy" to participate civically justifies restricting whose votes should count.

2022 study: Support for CN is associated with increased belief in voter fraud and laws limiting access to the ballot box.



Democratic Threats

To equality:

2021 study that revealed a higher tolerance of racists among Whites espousing Christian Nationalism relative to other White Americans.

To *peaceful* resolutions of disagreements:

Following Jan. 6, a group of political scientists found how CN — in connection w/ White identity, perceived victimhood, and a belief in conspiracy theories — is associated with greater support for political violence.
